Deep Questions

• Why is the subject of our kids leaving faith and the church so hard to speak about?

Some Statistics 40 - 50% of kids who graduate from a church or youth group will fail to stick with their faith in college.

Only 20 percent of college students who leave the faith planned to do so during high school. The remaining 80 % intended to stick with their faith but didn't.

- Statistics Within the LCMS
 Baptized LCMS membership reported for 2013 declined by 33,090 (or 1.51 %) from the number reported for 2012, for a total of 2,163,698 at the end of 2013.
- <u>Confirmed membership decreased by 21,912 for</u> 2013 to 1,685,597. A year earlier baptized membership for 2012 declined by 35,070 compared with 2011, and confirmed membership for 2012 decreased by 24,013 from the year before.



Why Bother?

Address the emotional needs of parents (Grandparents and Other Family Members) with prodigals Build a community for parents to interact Provide encouragement among parents

Creates a community that can be a resource to hurting parents and families in the congregation (Giving them a place to go)

Ways To Begin To Open Up

Initiate A Group Meeting In Your Congregation

How

Reach Out To Parents of Prodigals Offer A Weekly Bible Study Set Up Weekly Meeting Time & Location Put A Notice In Church Bulletin and Church Newsletter



Intended Group Audience

- Parents of Prodigals
- Grandparents
- Individuals that are believers and have prodigal family members
- Pastors and professional church workers if they have a prodigal in their family



Things To Consider As Group Leader

"Sensitivity of Subject Matter"

- Parents come to class blaming selves important to stress forgiveness
- Dealing with a multitude of emotions and reasons why children have left the faith
- If you are going to lead the group, are you also dealing with a prodigal in your life? (don't let that discourage you from leading)



Different Family Scenarios

- Reasons children leave the faith
 Family dynamics Highlights
- 1. Leaving the faith or organized traditional church
- 2. Toll on family, parents
- 3. Response by each parent
- 4. Vulnerability of meeting in a group
- 5. Fear of judgment
- 6. Family life, different styles of family

Forgiveness is KEY



How Do I Start?

After a thorough review of the introduction of the class material you may want to quit and not even start a group.

Questions To Ask Yourself:

1. What happens if parents just keep this sorrow to themselves? What will happen to them?

- 2. Could they benefit by sharing?
- 3. What would happen if we all started talking about it?



Slowly

- Sunday sermon series that broaches subject and gently preach about 'the prodigal' in a sermon or series
- Start a bible study with parents but don't delve into a study dealing with prodigals
- Get parents together who have "in common" their kids leaving the faith
- Highly recommend having an advocate within your congregation to get behind the study to lead from behind
 Also recommend having an introduction to share what the study is all about (similar to what we are having today) this will help break down the misconceptions that the study is to tell parents what they did wrong



Small Group Study Format

Study gently addresses the issue to encourage parents to open up

Stages of Curriculum Address situation

- Understanding the prodigal
- Class format that includes devotion, prayer, bible verses and questions
- Deeper questions for parents to reflect on
- A section on forgiveness ends each session forgiveness is • key



Create A Safe Environment

- Ensure confidentiality
- Don't put parents on the spot
- Keep group small | 4 -6 people may be ideal
- If you are a group leader that has a prodigal make sure you are at a place of peace before leading the group
- Create "Rules Of Engagement" for group



Group Confidentiality Contract Write Up 'Rules of Engagement' For Group

Example: "I will keep the testimonies and stories I hear in this group confidential. What is discussed in this group stays in this group and is not to be shared outside the group."



Purpose Of Meeting In A Small Group

- Encourages parents to begin to share their story
- Helps parents discover that they are not alone
- Provides opportunity to discover other parents responses to situation
- Creates opportunity to learn to learn from one another



Faith Family Reunion Present & Overall Vision

We hope to see parents begin emotional healing from the effects of hurt and a strained relationship with their prodigal. We hope to see pastors and church leaders being equipped with resources to address the emotional needs of parents of prodigals.

Faith Family Reunion's goal is to equip pastors and church leaders with tools that address hurting parents from our website resources to class curriculum that can be used within their congregations.



Faith Family Reunion Future

- In the future we envision congregations setting up weekly parent meetings, where church leaders and parents can come together to address the issues together (using the class curriculum).
- We envision congregations organizing mentoring programs so that older parents can work with younger parents to encourage them and share best family practices on how to raise their children in the faith.
- We envision congregations working together on a regional and national level to bring broken families together to address the issues and encourage one another.

- Imagine a future where parents are unafraid to share their hurts, sorrow and disappointments with others
- Imagine pastors and church leadership having the tools to reach out to hurting parents
- Imagine congregations working together on resolutions to reach out to prodigals and their parents

Provide resources to congregations, pastors and church leadership to engage hurting parents in order to:

1. Restore faith by reminding them of their identity in Jesus Christ

Renew faith in Jesus Christ by welcoming them in love which can help them to experience forgiveness and come to a place of forgiveness for themselves and the prodigal
 Remind them that faith in Jesus Christ ultimately brings hope

to their situation

Family

Create community and outreach, within the church family, for hurting parents by:

1. Demonstrating the love and caring of the church by reaching out to them as a church family

2. Creating a place where trust (within the church family) is built and offering a safe haven where the walls of pride, shame and secrecy can come down

3. Cultivating support and mentoring opportunities with the church family as members of the congregation, pastors and church leaders intentionally interact with them

Reunion

Help parents to come to an emotional place of peace to:

1. Reunite them with their prodigals in order to open the door for reconciliation with their family so they can share their faith in Jesus Christ authentically

2. Reunite individual families with their church family and create an opportunity for open and honest communication to create a strong familial bond within the congregation

3. Reunite pastors and church leaders with parents and the members of their congregation so that they can work together to engage the prodigal and members that have left the church


