Keynote Speaker

Rev. Dr. David R. Schmitt has long explored the intersections of faith and culture, particularly literary culture. He attended Concordia University Ann Arbor, Mich. (B.A. 1984), Concordia Seminary, St. Louis. Mo. (M.Div. 1988), and pursued a Master's Degree at the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, III. His first call was to St. John the Divine Lutheran Church in Chicago. After being called to teach at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, Mo. (1995), he attended Washington University, St. Louis, Mo. (M.A. 2002; Ph.D. 2005).

Dr. Schmitt has been writing and teaching courses in the Department of Practical Theology since 1995. Within the discipline of homiletics, he has analyzed the recent history of Lutheran preaching, has explored the Lutheran theology of preaching, and has integrated insights from the New Homiletic into preaching. Within the discipline of literary studies, he has taught courses in the devotional life and developed courses in the intersection of literary culture and theology.

Dr. Schmitt currently holds the Gregg H. Benidt Memorial Endowed Chair in Homiletics and Literature. He is interested in the intersection of faith and the visual arts and is working on two book projects: Beholding the Sacred, a homiletics text that explores the use of images in preaching, and Restoration Spiritualities, a literary study that explores faith and literary culture in the later seventeenth-century.


