

Finding Records for Michigan District & Congregations

LCMS Records of “Official Acts”

- If a congregation is currently active, records are kept on-site.
- If a congregation merged with another, the new organization should have kept early records.
- If the congregation disbanded or closed, records of official acts (baptisms, marriages, burials, confirmations, minutes of meetings) are normally sent to St. Louis and stored at the LCMS Archives
