The School of Missional Formation is:

- A fully accredited Master of Arts program;
- In association with Sioux Falls Seminary, Sioux Falls, SD and their Kairos Project;
- Uniquely Lutheran and under the ecclesiastical supervision of the Michigan District President (LCMS);
- Taught by LCMS instructors exclusively;
- Completely accessible online;
- Affordable.

Costs of the Master of Arts – Missional Formation:

- \$300 per month payable to Sioux Falls Seminary.
- Students may work at their personal pace and take as many courses as they wish at any time.
- It is estimated that an intentional student could complete the program in 13 months for a total cost of \$3,900. The range will be somewhere between \$3,000 and \$5,000.

How can I Pay for this Excellent Education?

- Students are encouraged to garner support from their home congregation where they will be serving.
- Some students may qualify for government education grants or loans.
- Students may qualify for a tax credit for education.
- Some students may qualify for a grant from the Michigan District's Deacon Training as monies are made available.

Requirements for admission:

- A bachelor's degree from an accredited university of college.
 - Sioux Falls Seminary is able to grant some "life experience" credit for students without an undergraduate degree.
- Complete application submission.
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Biographical essay inclusive of the student's Christian faith journey
- Documented support of the student's home congregation and supervising pastor

Successful Completion of the Master of Arts – Missional Formation Will:

- Prepare men and women for greater service in God's mission through His Church in His world.
- Meet the education requirement as a Credentialed or Licensed Deacon in the Michigan District.
- Meet the education requirement as a Ministry Assistant in the Michigan District.
- Provide a substantial portfolio and a recognized education degree for men applying to our LCMS seminaries toward ordination as a Specialized Ministry Pastor, Alternate Route, or full-time residential student (M.Div).
- Provide a substantial portfolio and a recognized education degree for women applying to our LCMS seminaries toward commissioning as Deaconesses.
