January 1 - Christmas 1

January 6 - Epiphany

January 29 - Epiphany 4

Feb 5 - Epiphany 5

1 Corinthians 2:6-7

“Yet among the mature we do impart wisdom, although it is not a wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are doomed to pass away. But we impart a secret and hidden wisdom of God, which God decreed before the ages for our glory.”

Feb 12 - Epiphany 6

February 26 - Lent 1

March 5 - Lent 2

Romans 4:16-17

“That is why it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed to all his offspring—not only to the adherent of the law but also to the one who shares the faith of Abraham, who is the father of us all, as it is written, “I have made you the father of many nations”—in the presence of the God in whom he believed, who gives life to the dead and calls into existence the things that do not exist.”

March 19 - Lent 4

John 9:25

March 26 - Lent 5

Romans 8:6

“For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the Spirit is life and peace.”

April 2 - Palm Sunday

Matthew 26:6-7

“Now when Jesus was at Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, a woman came up to Him with an alabaster flask of very expensive ointment, and she poured it on His head as He reclined at the table.”

April 6 - Maundy Thursday

Psalm 116:17-18

“I will offer to you the sacrifice of thanksgiving and call on the name of the Lord. I will pay my vows to the Lord in the presence of all His people.”

April 7 - Good Friday

Psalm 31:19

“Oh, how abundant is Your goodness, which You have stored up for those who fear You and worked for those who take refuge in You, in the sight of the children of mankind!”

April 9 - Easter

Colossians 3:2-3

“Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth. For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God.”

April 16 - Easter 2

Psalm 148:13

“Let them praise the name of the Lord, for His name alone is exalted; His majesty is above earth and heaven.”

April 23 - Easter 3

Psalm 116:12-13

“What shall I render to the Lord for all His benefits to me? I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the Lord. I will pay my vows to the Lord in the presence of all His people.”

April 30 - Easter 4

Acts 2:44-45

John 7:37-39

“On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.’” Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.”

“And how are they heard without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, ‘How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!’”

Psalm 67:5  
“Let the people praise You O God; let all the peoples praise you!”

Romans 12:1  
“I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.”

September 3 - Proper 17  
Romans 12:13  
“Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.”

September 10 - Proper 18  
Romans 13:8  
“Owe no one anything, except to love each other, for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law.”

September 17 - Proper 19  
Romans 14:12  
“So then each of us will give an account of himself to God.”

September 24 - Proper 20  
Philippians 1:27  
“Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving side by side for the faith of the gospel.”

October 1 - Proper 21  
Philippians 2:3-4  
“Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.”

October 8 - Proper 22  
Philippians 3:8  
“Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ.”

October 15 - Proper 23

Philippians 4:6-7

“Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

October 22 - Proper 24

1 Thessalonians 1:2-3

“We give thanks to God always for all of you, constantly mentioning you in our prayers, remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labor of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.”

October 29 - Reformation Day

John 8:31-32

“So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed in him, ‘If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.’ ”

November 5 - All Saints’ Day

Revelation 7:15-17

“Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will shelter them with his presence. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any scorching heat. For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.”

“First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.”
