# **Team Camp Area:**

• We recommend tents to be set up either near the finish line area or along the starting line area. Tents CANNOT be set up behind the starting line. Please be mindful of the course, and leave ample space for our runners.

## **Course Maps:**

- There are 2 course maps located in this packet.
- This is a one-loop course with a hill just before the first mile.

### **Starting Line:**

• The starting line will be divided into boxes. Each school will have a box assignment (located in this packet).

#### **Individual and Team Awards:**

- Top 8 runners in each division will receive medals [Boys A (7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup>), Boys B (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>), Girls A (7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>), Girls B (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>)]
- All girls, regardless of grade, run together in the first race. All boys, regardless of grade, run together in the second race. Each boys and girls top 5 runners, regardless of grade, will make up their boys and girls team scores, respectively. The Champion and Runner-up teams on both the boy's and girl's side will receive a trophy.

#### **Reminders:**
